St. Michael's Academic Family Health Team is inviting applications from a qualified family physician for locum family at the 61 Queen Street East site. The successful candidate must be:

- A family physician with a demonstrated interest in working with marginalized populations in an inner-city context, for a FHO/FHT roster of approximately **700-800 patients for 0.4-0.5 FTE**
- Practice has a high proportion of women and children. Option for prenatal/FMOB coverage, but not required. If you are interested in Family Medicine Obstetrics, there is also an opportunity to join the FMOB call group with great mentorship.
- Hold a MD degree and certification in Family Medicine from the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
- Providing comprehensive virtual & in-person clinical care, including teaching undergraduate and postgraduate learners.
- Eligible for an academic appointment within the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto.

This practice is well supported by a variety of Allied Health Professionals including Nursing, Clinical Pharmacist, Social Worker/Mental Health Professionals, Dietician, Physiotherapy and other professionals. Administrative support is provided by receptionists and on-site managers. The office uses Telus PS Suite EMR.

Remuneration is set at \$450/half day (9-12pm, or 1-4pm, or 5-8pm). Weekend/evening clinics not mandatory, but may be available if desired.

The start date is **July 1, 2023 – Nov 12, 2023** (*dates may be flexible*).
